COLORADO MASONS' BENEVOLENT FUND SCHOLARSHIP

PURPOSE: These scholarships are intended to provide financial assistance to deserving students. They are not intended to cover all expenses.

AWARD: Award amounts are not determined by the Board until at least February 2018. In the past, we have awarded scholarships up to \$7,000 per year, and are renewable for up to 4 years. These scholarships are intended to assist in obtaining an undergraduate degree from a university or college, or training in other accredited schools of higher education within the State of Colorado. Scholarships are awarded without reference to race, religion, sex, national origin or Masonic relationship. **ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR APPLICANTS:** 1. You must be a graduating Colorado Public High School Senior. 2. You must be a citizen of the United States of America. 3. You must attend an institution of higher education within the State of Colorado. 4. Completed applications must be submitted by **March 15, 2018** to be considered.

Colorado Press Association Scholarship - High School Students

This scholarship program was created by the Colorado Press Association for high school seniors who have demonstrated commitment to the field of print and online journalism to continue their pursuit of study within this field.

Eligibility:

Students who meet ALL of the following criteria are encouraged to apply.

- Will graduate from a Colorado high school in the spring of the term they are applying for the scholarship
- Have held at least one leadership position (e.g. editor, president, treasurer, etc.) in a student media organization like the high school newspaper, yearbook or media club during their senior year
- Will attend an accredited four-year college or university in Colorado in the fall
- Must plan to use their major in the print or online journalism industry in Colorado after college graduation.

Please note that the following media related majors will not be eligible for this opportunity: multimedia, technical journalism, documentary film making, media students, and mass communications, etc.)

Eligibility: U.S. students 18 years of age or younger.

Deadline: 2/28/2018

Award: \$15,000 (grand prize), \$10,000 - \$2,500 (second - tenth Place)

Deadline: 2/28/2018

Eligibility: U.S. high school students.
