

Hello seniors and parents/guardians of seniors,

It is the time of the school year when we start preparing for the senior video. The senior video has become a tradition in Limon and has become a fairly large production. The sooner I can get pictures and the question sheet turned in, the sooner I can get working on this large project.

I would like 20-30 pictures in total. I will not use them all, but it is better to have too many to choose from, than too few. In order to have any kind of theme for the video, I would like to give you a set of guidelines to help you gather the pictures I need. Here is what I need:

- 2 “Senior Pictures”. These are pictures specifically taken for senior students. They don’t need to be professionally taken, just current pictures taken only of the graduate. I can make it work with one, but I will use two if you have them. If you give me more than two, please indicate which ones you’d prefer.
- 1 baby picture. I’d prefer not to have a newborn pic, 6-12 months is better. Most newborns pictures look alike. If you give me more than one, please indicate which one you want me to use for the baby picture.
- 2-4 pictures around toddler age.
- 2-4 pictures grade school age. This can be class pictures, or any at that age level.
- 2-4 pictures grade school age with classmates and friends. Even if the graduate did not grow up in Limon.
- 1-2 pictures toddler age to grade school age with siblings or other relatives of a similar age.
- 1-2 pictures with family. Family pictures, special events, family trips, etc.
- 1-2 pictures middle school age with friends, classmates, and/or peers.
- 2-4 pictures high school age in sports, band, speech, FFA, and/or other activities the student is involved with.
- 2-4 pictures high school age with friends.
- 1-4 misc. pictures that isn’t covered above.

There are several ways to get your pictures to me.

- I will set up a scanner in Mrs. Larson’s classroom that can be used to scan pictures. I will not scan your pictures. There will be some instruction on operating the scanner.
- You can also submit a flash drive with your photos. I will make every effort to return your flash drive, but I make no promises.
- You can also email me your pictures. My address is martinezc@limonbadgers.com. Please indicate the graduates name with the email.

Rules for picture format:

- JPEG or PNG picture formats only. **NO PDF FILES!**
- 1 picture per file. Do not send a picture with more than one image on it. It takes too long for me to separate to individual pictures.
- At least 150-300 dpi. Sometimes I need to crop the pictures. If the resolution is too low, the pictures may be fuzzy. Too high of resolution is just a waste of file space.
